# VIKING GRILLFESTIVALEN COOKS PACKET

Welcome! Thank you for choosing to participate in the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Viking Grillfestivalen hosted by the Viking Parent Crew (VPC) of Vanguard College Preparatory School. The event will be held November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 at Brazos Park East near downtown Waco.

The proceeds of this event will help fund scholarships for Vanguard students and support the organizations mission statement of academic accomplishment, social development, athletic participation and the enjoyment of the arts and ethical behavior.

Central Texas is known for a rich history of BBQ Tradition, and with this event, we are ensuring that the tradition will continue for years to come.

## CHECK-IN

All BBQ teams must check in Friday (Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>) 12:00PM-7:00PM. Please enter via the Main Gate and check in. Overnight camping for competitors only. You may arrive after this time if prior arrangements are made. If you are unable to check in at these times, please contact the Event Organizers so we can make alternative arrangements.

## COMPETITOR SITE INFORMATION

- **Since this is a school sponsored event, alcohol beverages need to be concealed.**
- Sites are 20'x40' with the option to add an additional 20'x40' – keep contained within your site. Sites will be assigned with paid Application.
- Potable water will be available but you will need to provide your own hoses.
- Electricity can be ordered through Application. Make connection on arrival and bring your own Y-connector and extension cords.
- Please be sure to disconnect vehicles. You may park your vehicle in your space as long as you stay within the 20'x40' area you are assigned to.
- Ice by the bag will be available on site from Event Producer. There is an option to purchase additional ice.
- Outdoor restrooms will be available.
- Trashcans will be placed in front of sites; Event Producer will pick up.
- Ash and grease must be brought to the designated disposal area.
- Sanitation wash, rinse, sanitize will be checked at meat inspections. Proper handling of food required; vinyl or latex gloves should be used.
- Proper storage of meat is required; it MUST be maintained below 40°F or above 140°F.
- Fire extinguisher MUST be currently inspected and on site at all times. You will not be allowed to cook or serve if it is not currently inspected.
- Upon leaving, please police your area and leave it clean and free of debris and trash. Drop your last trash in dumpster on way out. Absolutely NO ash may be dumped on the ground.

## **SATURDAY'S KCBS COMPETITION:**

The contest is sanctioned by the Kansas City Barbeque Society and abides by all KCBS rules & regulations. Contestants will be competing in the following categories: Chicken, Pork Ribs, Pork, and Brisket. The following ancillary categories will also be judged: Sauce, Side and Dessert. Entries in the ancillary category do not have to be prepared on site; however, do not use store bought. Awards and prize money will be presented for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion, as well as from 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> places in each individual main category. Sauce will be a ½ pot split for 1<sup>st</sup> place only, Side and Dessert will payout for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places. The guaranteed payout for this event will be \$5000.
